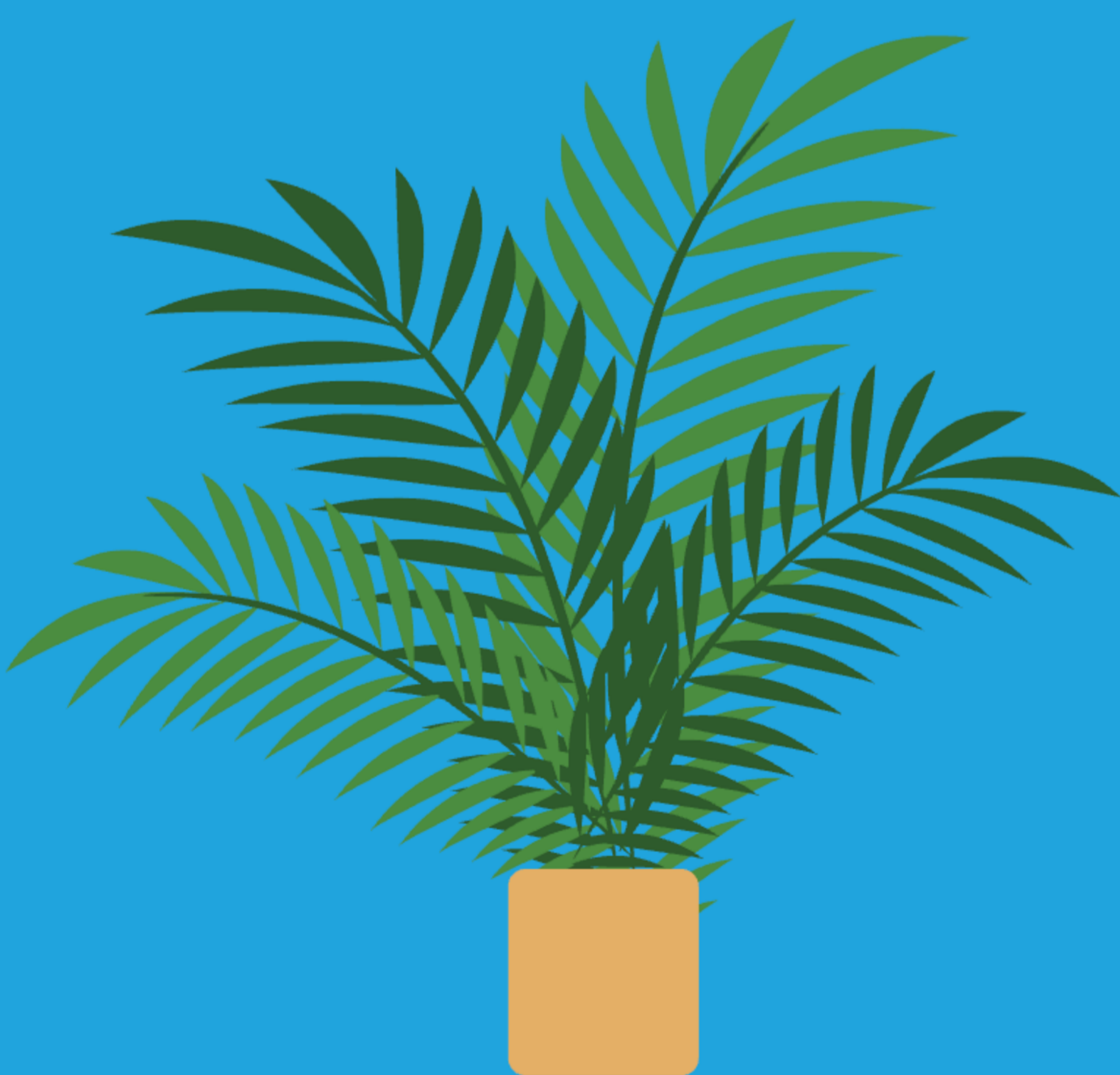

Community Session Proposals

Guaranteed placement for Protector level and above

NGO-ISAC is opening session programming to the community. Members, vendors, and sponsors alike are invited to submit proposals for sessions, roundtables, demos, and other formats. We believe the best programming comes from the people doing the work, and this process is designed to surface a diverse range of voices and topics.

Protector and Community Champion sponsors interested in this opportunity are **guaranteed a session slot** through this process. Sessions are collaborative by design – sponsors won't be presenting alone, but will co-create the session with NGO-ISAC and/or other community members to ensure it's interactive and grounded in real community needs. Submit a proposal and we'll work with you to find the right fit and format on the agenda. Possible formats include:

- Interactive exercises and skill-building activities
- Birds of a Feather small-group facilitation
- Case study presentation and discussion
- Trend analysis presentation and discussion
- Panel discussion
